



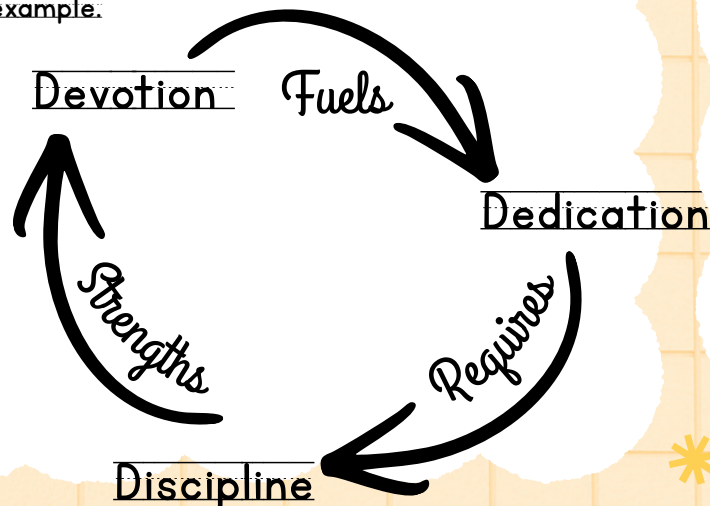

- ☐ Listen respectfully
- ☐ Ask questions when confused
- ☐ Speak politely to others

- ☐ Keep a room organized
- ☐ Wash hands and practice hygiene
- ☐ Brush teeth independently
- ☐ Dress independently
